All entries must submit a reservation for the show. No entries will be accepted at the show without a prior reservation. Canceling an entry will NOT incur a scratch fee or any type of penalty.

With this in mind, we ask that you notify us as early as possible if you have a reservation that you know you will not use. This will allow us to notify anyone on the waitlist. This policy is in place in an effort to keep our shows at a volume that allows for a quality experience for all participants and staff. Show Policies & Procedures

Reservation Procedure: All entries (both haul-in and stalled) must make a reservation for the show by the reservation deadline. All reservations must be made by emailing rivercityequestrianevents@gmail.com. It is preferred that reservations are made by a trainer, not individually. Reservations are accepted on a first come, first serve basis until the reservation deadline or the show sells out; whichever happens first. Reservations made after the deadline will be accepted if capacity allows.

Entry Submission: It is strongly encouraged that entries are submitted prior to the show. Entries can be submitted online using horseshowtime.com; or via PDF format emailed to rivercityequestrianevents@gmail.com.

All stall deposits must be sent by Reservation deadline.

If paying a deposit by check, please mail check Payable to River City Equestrian Events to PO Box 243, Davis, CA 95617.

Feed & Bedding: Feed and bedding can be ordering before or during the show by emailing rivercityequestrianevents@gmail.com

Friday Schooling: Friday Schooling in the show arenas is available for \$25 per horse from 12pm-5pm. Please be advised that no medic will be on site for Friday schooling.

Weekend Schooling: NO JUMPING. Arenas will be open for hacking only (daylight permitted) up until one hour prior to the start of the show or until the tractor drags the arena. Arenas will be open after the show for hacking only after the course for the following day is set until sunset.

RV Spaces: RVspace reservation must be made by emailing rivercityequestrianevents@gmail.com. Reservations cannot be made with Murieta Equestrian Center directly. RV spaces are \$175 for the show. (Thursday-Sunday). We do not offer a nightly rate.

Billing: There will be a \$40 charge on all returned checks. No numbers will be issued without an open check or credit card on file in the office. A \$40 charge will be issued to any accounts that must be billed after the show's conclusion.

Rules: US Equestrian Federation and SAHJA guidelines will be followed. The decisions of management and judges are final.

Awards: Awards to 1st; ribbons to 6th.

Class Size: Classes with less than 3 may be combined or canceled. If entries warrant; large classes will be split.

Lunging: Lunging is only permitted in the designated lunging arena and will not be permitted once the show begins. Any fees assessed by the facility for lunging in closed arenas will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.

Attire: Boots, collared shirts, approved helmets and breeches are required.

Dogs: All dogs must be leashed and the leash must be in control of a responsible human handler. Those in non-compliance may be fined an additional \$25 which will be added to the owner's bill, fine is at management's discretion.

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG(s).

Schedule: The schedule indicated in this prize list is tentative. Based on entry numbers and other factors, schedules may be updated at any time leading up to the show or during the show. Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel entries, awards, or prizes, and/or adjust the time schedule, combine, scratch, or move classes as necessary without claims or damage.

Short Stirrup: Open to riders 11 and under that are not competing in any class at this show with fences 3'0" or higher or have never shown in previous years over fences 3'0" or higher.

Long Stirrup: Open to riders 12 & over that have never shown over fences 3'0" or higher.

Pony Hunters: Open to ponies 14.2 hands and under ridden by a junior.

SAHJA Medal Classes: Riders do not need to be SAHJA members. Points are awarded based on the number starting the class. Five points qualifies for the Finals. Please see SAHJA Rulebook for Medal Specifications.

Non-Comp Rounds: Non-comp rounds are permitted with management approval. Once a horse has completed (a) non-comp round(s), it may no longer compete in the respective arena for the remainder of the day.

Non-Showing Horses: Horses not competing in the show will pay a \$25 schooling fee and a \$50 non-showing fee.

Classes 1, 14, 31 & 76 Warm-Up Hunters: This class is open all day long, running concurrently with any Hunter classes. A horse may only compete once per day in this class. If a horse is entered in additional hunter classes at the same height, the Warm-Up Hunter course must be the first course completed.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER

For valuable consideration and to induce permission to participate in equestrian activities held at Murieta Equestrian Center ("MEC"), 7200 Lone Pine Drive, Rancho Murieta, CA 95683, each of the undersigned agrees to the following terms and makes the following warranties:

I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any equestrian event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of MEC or Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers.

With this in mind, I accept full responsibility for my own safety and EXPRESSLY ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM, whether foreseen or unforeseen while participating in equestrian activities at the Murieta Equestrian Center. I am physically fit and know of no medical or health reason why I should not participate in this activity.

I hereby RELEASE and agree to DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS MEC, Cosumnes Corporation, their shareholders, officers, employees, agents, instructors, equipment manufacturers, lessors, and insurers (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Parties Released"), from and against any liability, demand, claim, or right of action for any damage or injury, including paralysis or death, to any person or property, even if such damage or personal injury results from the NEGLIGENCE of MEC or other Parties Released. I further COVENANT NOT TO SUE or make any demand or claim against MEC or other Parties Released, for or by reason of any such damage or personal injury from my participation in equestrian activities at MEC. I will pay all fees, damages, and costs, including attorney fees that MEC or other Parties Released may incur in the enforcement of this agreement.

A signed liability waiver is a condition to your participation in any event. Failure to sign will lead to your disqualification and removal from property. I have carefully read this document and fully understand its contents, which I adopt as a completely integrated and exclusive statement of the entire terms of agreement.

PUBLISHING OF PICTURES, VIDEOS, & COMPETITION SHOTS ON PROPERTY - Murieta Equestrian Center may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage, or benefit of the competition, sport, or facility.
