THE SAJHA MEDAL FINALS WILL TAKE PLACE DURING A SPECIFIED SPRING SAHJA HORSE SHOW, BETWEEN THE FIRST FULL WEEKEND IN APRIL AND THE LAST FULL WEEKEND IN JUNE, AND WILL BE CONDUCTED UNDER A MULTIPLE JUDGE SYSTEM WITH OPEN SCORING. FINALISTS WILL BE JUDGED OVER TWO COMPLETE COURSES, AND AT LEAST THE TOP FOUR RIDERS WILL RETURN TO PERFORM ADDITIONAL WORK. THE SAHJA PONY MEDAL SHALL BE JUDGED OVER A COURSE OF FENCES 2'3" IN HEIGHT. THE SAHJA MINI MEDAL SHALL BE JUDGED OVER A COURSE OF FENCES 2'6" IN HEIGHT. THE SAHJA CHILD/ ADULT MEDAL SHALL BE JUDGED OVER A COURSE OF FENCES 3' IN HEIGHT. RIDERS COMPETING IN THE FINALS MUST BE MEMBERS OF SAHJA. ALL RIDERS WILL RETURN FOR A SECOND ROUND. SCORING WILL BE OPEN NUMERIC SCORING, WITH SCORES ANNOUNCED AFTER EACH ROUND. FIRST ROUND SCORES FROM EACH JUDGE WILL BE AVERAGED FOR A SINGLE SCORE, SECOND ROUND SCORES WILL ALSO BE AVERAGED FOR A SINGLE SCORE. THESE TWO SCORES WILL BE ADDED TOGETHER AND AVERAGED FOR ONE SCORE TO BE CARRIED INTO THE WORK-OFF, ANY WORK OFF WILL BE GIVEN ITS OWN SCORE BY EACH JUDGE AND THIS SCORE SHALL BE ADDED TO THE SUBTOTAL AND AVERAGED AGAIN FOR THE FINAL SCORE. WORK-OFF SCORES WILL BE ANNOUNCED. HIGHEST TOTAL SCORE IS THE WINNER. RIBBONS ARE PRESENTED 1ST THROUGH 10TH.

### Show Policies & Procedures

Reservation Procedure: All entries (both haul-in and stalled) must make a reservation for the show by the reservation deadline. All reservations must be made by emailing rivercityequestrianevents@gmail.com. It is preferred that reservations are made by a trainer, not individually. Reservations are accepted on a first come, first serve basis until the reservation deadline or the show sells out; whichever happens first. Reservations made after the deadline will be accepted if capacity allows.

**Entry Submission:** It is strongly encouraged that entries are submitted prior to the show. Entries can be submitted online using horseshowtime.com; or via PDF format emailed to rivercityequestrianevents@gmail.com.

All stall deposits must be sent by Reservation deadline.

If paying a deposit by check, please mail check Payable to River City Equestrian Events to PO Box 243, Davis, CA 95617.

Feed & Bedding: Feed and bedding can be ordering before or during the show by emailing <a href="mailto:rivercityequestrianevents@gmail.com">rivercityequestrianevents@gmail.com</a>

**Wednesday Schooling:** Please see the show schooling schedule for heights and times.

Schooling Thurs-Sun: Arenas will be open for hacking only in the mornings up until one hour prior to the start of the show or until the tractor drags the arena (Exception: no hacking in the arena prior to the start of the Hunter Derby or Medal Finals). Arenas will be open after the show for schooling only after the course for the following day is set until sunset.

RV Spaces: RV space reservations must be made by emailing rivercityequestrianevents@gmail.com. Reservations cannot be made with Murieta Equestrian Center directly. RV spaces are \$300 for the show. (Tuesday-Sunday). We do not offer a nightly rate.

**Billing:** There will be a \$50 charge for all checks returned by the bank, or 10% of the check amount-whichever is greater. Once a check has been returned, a credit card will be required as payment for all future transactions. No numbers will be issued without an open check or credit card on file in the office. A \$40 charge will be issued to any accounts that must be billed after the show's conclusion.

**Rules:** US Equestrian Federation and SAHJA guidelines will be followed. The decisions of management and judges are final.

Awards: Awards to 1st; ribbons to 6th.

**Class Size:** Classes with less than 3 may be combined or canceled. If entries warrant; large classes will be split.

**Lunging:** Lunging is only permitted in the designated lunging arena and will not be permitted once the show begins. Any fees assessed by the facility for lunging in closed arenas will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.

**Attire:** Boots, collared shirts, approved helmets and breeches are required.

**Dogs:** All dogs must be leashed and the leash must be in control of a responsible human handler. Those in non-compliance may be fined an additional \$25 which will be added to the owner's bill, fine is at management's discretion.

#### PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG(s).

**Schedule:** The schedule indicated in this prize list is tentative. Based on entry numbers and other factors, schedules may be updated at any time leading up to the show or during the show. Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel entries, awards, or prizes, and/or adjust the time schedule, combine, scratch, or move classes as necessary without claims or damage.

**Short Stirrup:** Open to riders 11 and under that are not competing in any class at this show with fences 3'0" or higher or have never shown in previous years over fences 3'0" or higher.

**Long Stirrup:** Open to riders 12 & over that have never shown over fences 3'0" or higher.

**Pony Hunters:** Open to ponies 14.2 hands and under ridden by a junior.

**SAHJA Medal Classes**: Riders do not need to be SAHJA members. Points are awarded based on the number starting the class. Five points qualifies for the Finals. Please see SAHJA Rulebook for Medal Specifications.

**Non-Comp Rounds:** Non-comp rounds are permitted with management approval. Once a horse has completed (a) non-comp round(s), it may no longer compete in the respective arena for the remainder of the day. The cost of a non-comp round is the same as the cost of a regular class.

**Non-Showing Horses:** Horses not competing in the show will pay a \$35 schooling fee and a \$65 non-showing fee.

Classes 1,7,15,29,41,82 & 95: Warm-Up Hunters (Open All Day): This class is open all day long, running concurrently with any Hunter classes. A horse may only compete once per day in this class. If a horse is entered in additional hunter classes at the same height, the Warm-Up Hunter course must be the first course completed.

## MURIETA EQUESTRIAN CENTER ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER

For valuable consideration and to induce permission to participate in equestrian activities held at Murieta Equestrian Center ("MEC"), 7200 Lone Pine Drive, Rancho Murieta, CA 95683, each of the undersigned agrees to the following terms and makes the following warranties:

I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any equestrian event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of MEC or Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers.

With this in mind, I accept full responsibility for my own safety and EXPRESSLY ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM, whether foreseen or unforeseen while participating in equestrian activities at the Murieta Equestrian Center. I am physically fit and know of no medical or health reason why I should not participate in this activity.

I hereby RELEASE and agree to DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS MEC, Cosumnes Corporation, their shareholders, officers, employees, agents, instructors, equipment manufacturers, lessors, and insurers (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Parties Released"), from and against any liability, demand, claim, or right of action for any damage or injury, including paralysis or death, to any person or property, even if such damage or personal injury results from the NEGLIGENCE of MEC or other Parties Released. I further COVENANT NOT TO SUE or make any demand or claim against MEC or other Parties Released, for or by reason of any such damage or personal injury from my participation in equestrian activities at MEC.
